OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Check the voltage of the adaptor is the same as source of current, Connect the power adaptor to the handle, and plug adaptor into wall socket.
- 2. Choose your tip and insert into handle, ensure position is secured.

A WARNING

WARNING! Never use any other type of wire for replacement! May cause damage to adaptor! Use only our replacement wire or use dia. 0.23mm resistance wire.

Draw the design on the foam. Or cut a pattern, pin to the foam, and make a rough trace of the pattern, then remove pattern.

MAINTENANCE

WARNING! Before cleaning or carrying out any maintenance procedure, ensure that the charger have been removed.

Cleaning

- Keep the ventilation slots of the tool clean at all times to ensure efficient operation.
- After each use, blow air through the tool housing to ensure it is free from all dust, dirt, etc. Build up of dust or dirt particles may cause the tool to overheat and shorten the life of the tool.
- If the housing of the tool requires cleaning, do not use solvents. Use of a cloth only is recommended.
- Never allow any liquid to get inside the tool, never immerse any part of the tool into liquid.
