SAFETY WARNINGS

1. When using the torque wrench, always follow local safety regulations and standard workshop practices.
2. Read and understand this instruction manual before operating the tool.
3. Inspect the torque wrench before each use. Do not use it if any parts are damaged, loose, or worn.
4. Always select the correct torque value according to the manufacturer's specifications before tightening fasteners.
5. Hold the wrench firmly by the handle and apply force smoothly until the wrench clicks. Do not continue applying force after the click is heard or felt.
6. Never use the torque wrench as a breaker bar or for loosening stubborn fasteners unless it is specifically designed for bidirectional operation.
6. Do not exceed the maximum rated torque capacity of the wrench, as this may damage the tool and affect calibration accuracy.
7. Wear approved eye protection when working around mechanical equipment or fasteners.

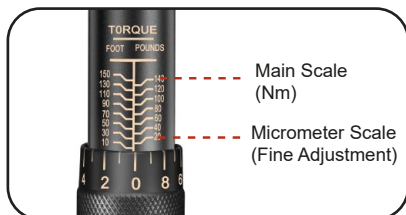
HOW TO USE

1 UNLOCK THE HANDLE



Turn the lock knob counterclockwise to unlock the handle.

2 SET THE TORQUE



Turn the lock knob counterclockwise to unlock the handle.

3 UNLOCK THE HANDLE



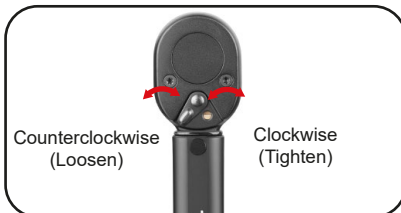
Turn the lock knob clockwise to lock the torque setting.

4 ATTACH THE SOCKET



Attach the appropriate size socket to the 1/2"square drive..

5 SELECT DIRECTION



Attach the appropriate size socket to the 1/2"square drive..

6 TIGHTEN STOP AT CLICK



Pull the handle smoothly. When you hear or feel a "click", stop applying force immediately.
